Subject: Strengthening Import Procedures for Road Components – Requirement for Prior Licensing.

Dear Agents,

Within the framework of legislative changes applicable to import processes and in compliance with Presidential Decree No. 155/20, dated June 1st, which approves the Regulation on the Activities of Importation, Trade, and Technical Assistance for Road Equipment, a new control mechanism has been established to enhance compliance with import operations.

Thus, import licenses for road components are now a prerequisite for obtaining the Loading Certificate.

Accordingly, any importer within your jurisdiction intending to export the components specified in the table below must, in addition to submitting the final invoice, Bill of Lading (B/L), and Single Document (D.U.), also present prior authorization issued by the National Land Transport Agency (ANTT), as stipulated in paragraphs 2 to 5 of Article 17 of the aforementioned decree.

Additionally, we hereby inform you that, beyond the requirement for prior authorization for vehicle shipments, such authorization is now also mandatory for the following harmonized tariff codes, ensuring greater accuracy in the classification of components to be imported into Angola.

Harmonized Code	Merchandise Description
8408.20	Engines – of the type used for vehicle propulsion.
8708.40	Gearboxes – including gears and their parts.
8706.00	Chassis – with engines for motor vehicles classified under positions 87.01 to 87.05.
87.07	Bodies – for motor vehicles classified under positions 87.01 to 87.05, including cabins.
8708.94	Steering Systems – including steering wheels, columns, and cables, along with their parts.
8708.80	Suspension Systems – and their parts (including suspension shock absorbers).
8708.50	Transmission Systems.

In this context, and with the aim of updating procedures in accordance with the current regulatory framework, we inform you that the measures now adopted enter into force with immediate effect.

**ORDINANCE No. 002/CA/2025**

Considering that **Presidential Decree No. 155/20, of 1 June**, approves the Regulation on the Importation, Trade and Technical Assistance of Road Equipment, establishing the mandatory requirement to obtain prior authorisation for the import of such equipment;

Recognising the need to reinforce control mechanisms and improve the rules and procedures applicable to the issuance of Loading Certificates, with a view to ensuring the effective implementation of the aforementioned legal instrument and to promoting enhanced oversight of the commercialisation of both new and used vehicles within the national territory, thereby contributing to increased road safety and the protection of the public interest;

Taking into account that the Regulatory Agency for Cargo Certification and Logistics of Angola (ARCCLA) must cooperate with other public entities upon request;

Pursuant to the combined provisions of points g) and k) of paragraph 1 of Article 20, point c) of paragraph 1 of Article 8, and paragraph 5 of Article 10 of the Organic Statute of ARCCLA, approved by **Presidential Decree No. 326/20, of 29 December**, in conjunction with point a) of paragraph 2 of Article 31 of the Angolan Code of Administrative Procedure;

**It is hereby decreed as follows:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Scope**

1.1 This Ordinance establishes the requirement of prior import authorisation as a precondition for the issuance of the Loading Certificate for road equipment.

1.2 For the purposes of this Ordinance, *road equipment* shall be understood to include vehicles, systems, parts, and components as listed in the Annex, which forms an integral part of this legal instrument.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Scope of Application

This Ordinance shall apply to all International Agents accredited by ARCCLA in the exercise of their competences related to the issuance of Loading Certificates.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Precondition and Mandatory Compliance

3.1 The import authorisation licence, issued under the terms of Presidential Decree No. 155/20, shall constitute a mandatory prerequisite for the issuance of the corresponding Loading Certificate.

3.2 Pursuant to point c) of paragraph 2 of Clause One of the Agency Agreements entered into with ARCCLA, International Agents are required to demand the presentation of the said licence from importers, under penalty of non-compliance with the applicable legal and regulatory provisions.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Interpretation and Omissions

Any doubts or omissions arising from the interpretation or application of this Ordinance shall be resolved by the Board of Directors of ARCCLA.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Entry into Force

This Ordinance shall enter into force immediately upon its publication.
